How to help - Identify protection strategies

- ☑ Report harmful and inappropriate material to host websites when you see that
- ☑ Discuss how to minimise use, password protect or turn off in-app purchases.
- ✓ Install software to filter out harmful and inappropriate content (parental controls)
- ☑ Use time settings to control duration of online activity
- ☑ Explain what is or isn't allowed (ie no personal info to strangers, e-purchases)
- ☑ Monitor/supervise online activity
- ☑ Get and give support on how to block and report people when needed
- ☑ Explore content with your child or young person and agree on boundaries
- ☑ Manage privacy settings to restrict sharing and who can view content
- ☑ Increase resilience and trust by talking regularly with your child and support your child to talk with others about e-safety
